Competent Communicator Projects

Ensure someone evaluates you during the meeting using the appropriate section in the CC manual. Aim to complete one speech and one Competent Leadership project each month.

1	The Ice Breaker Just get up there and kick off your speaking practice. This is a slightly shorter speech (4-6 minutes instead of the usual 5-7 minutes) and can be about anything related to you. Download the speech project excerpt here.	
2	Organize Your Speech For your second speech, you focus on the organization and clarity of outline. Make sure to include and practice an opening and conclusion, and have clear points in between.	
3	Get to the Point Your third speech should have a key message - state your key message early and use your speech to provide supporting points.	
4	How to Say It Focus on the actual words and delivery of your speech, including word choice, sentence structure, and rhetorical devices. Typically speeches involve topics that lend themselves to evoking the senses.	
5	Your Body Speaks Use body language - posture, stance, eye contact, facial expressions, gestures.	
6	Vocal Variety Varying your voice in terms of voice level, pace, and pauses.	
7	Research Your Topic Back up arguments with research and evidence to make your speech stronger.	
8	Visual Aids Employ visual aids – props, drawing on a whiteboard, etc.	
9	Persuade with Power Deliver a powerful, persuasive message.	
10	Inspire Your Audience Pull together the skills from the first 9 speeches to deliver an inspirational speech
